GLOBAL EHS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (GEMS)

The ability to monitor, trend, and evaluate all Environmental, Health & Safety (EHS) incidents throughout Boart Longyear's global operational footprint is a critical component of our EHS management system. Our Global EHS Management System (GEMS) is a web-based program that captures data relating to injuries, motor vehicle incidents, equipment damage, environmental impacts and other safety related incidents.

GEMS quickly disseminates key EHS information on a global scale. It does this via instant e-mail notifications for events entered into the system and distributes a variety of customized daily and monthly summary reports.

GEMS has instilled a global consistency throughout Boart Longyear's EHS programs and allows us to deliver a "One Boart Longyear" effort to our clients. We can now avoid EHS incidents in Chile from trends that are happening in Russia. Our GEMS system allows us to recognize, evaluate, and control hazards arising in our workforce. It has proven to be a valuable tool in our EHS efforts.

In an attempt to keep workers safe, we make significant efforts to eliminate work-related risks through product engineering. In combination with automated rod handlers designed to keep workers safely away from machinery we are pursuing a number of hand-tool solutions to eliminate hand injuries.

Rod Lifter

One of those solutions is our new handheld, lightweight Rod Lifter designed to:

- Ergonomically keep the wrist and hand in a neutral position and eliminate strain
- Remove fingers from pinch points and sharp surfaces
- Allow for proper lifting techniques and body positioning
- Prevent thread damage
- Prevent pipe slippage through the use of a specially designed carbide grip

- Ergonomically fit employees' hands, keeping fingers away from dangerous areas
- Fit multiple split tube diameters with one device
- Eliminate hand contact with sharp edges
