RESULTS OF 2023 ANNUAL GENERAL AND SPECIAL MEETING; QUARTERLY REPORTING CHANGE

Boart Longyear Group Ltd. The next periodic report will be the half year report for the period ending 30 June 2023 due no later than 31 August 2023.
