Government Funding

Employment History

- In 2008, Boart Longyear had ~150 employees in the Adelaide area (Mitchell Park and Lonsdale). Of these 150, ~50% were shop-floor skilled labour (machinists, welders).
- In 2009, as a result of the Global Financial Crisis, the total number of Adelaide-based employees fell by around 40 %.
- In 2010, when market demand began to recover, Boart Longyear decided to concentrate and re-build its engineering and technology research teams in Adelaide.
- In 2008, Boart Longyear employed ~ 10 engineers in Adelaide.
- Today, we employ over 50 engineers and technicians in Adelaide. The skills mix of our workforce has shifted dramatically in favour of highly-trained, higher paying positions.
- Adelaide houses the single largest group of engineers in the Boart Longyear global engineering network. (Globally, we have engineers located in US, Canada, Poland, China, and Germany).

Boart Longyear is a 120-year-old global mineral exploration company that provides mineral exploration services and drilling products for the global mining industry and also has a substantial drilling presence for water exploration, environmental sampling, energy, and oil sands exploration.
